AAUW-Harriet Haines Scholarship

- Classified student enrolled at least half-time (6 credits) at MCC or UH Center on Maui (UH Manoa, UHWO, UH Hilo).
- Preference will be given in the following order: women; women returning to school; students demonstrating academic potential, and financial need.
- Minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.00.
- Maui County resident and US citizen.

AAUW-Dorothy Shimer Scholarship

- Classified student enrolled at least half-time (6 credits) at MCC or UH Center on Maui (UH Manoa, UHWO, UH Hilo).
- Preference will be given in the following order: women; single parents, students returning to the workforce or changing careers, students demonstrating academic potential, and financial need.
- Minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.00.
- Maui County resident and US citizen.

Adlawan and Heritage Endowed Scholarship

- Classified student enrolled at least half-time (6 credits) at MCC (with the intention of continuing a Bachelor's degree program).
- Preference given to full-time student and/or single parent.
- Demonstrate financial need with preference given to students who do not receive federal financial aid or tuition waivers and have not received more than two scholarships including this one.
- Minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.00
- Hawai'i resident and US citizen.

Alpha Delta Kappa Fidelis Gamma Scholarship Fund

- Classified student enrolled at full-time (12 credits) at MCC or UH Center on Maui,
- Preference given to students working toward a degree in education or to non-traditional women students returning to college
- U.S. citizen.

- Financial need as defined by federal guidelines.

- Classified student enrolled at least half-time (6 credits).
- Priority will be given to students in the Sustainable Technology Program.
- Minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5.

Walter and Demaris Fredericksen Memorial Scholarship

- Classified student enrolled at least half-time (6 credits).
- Preference given in the following order: Hawaiian Studies, Marine Options, Anthropology, or Archeology
- Minimum cumulative grade point average or 2.5 GPA.
- Maui County resident.

- Classified student enrolled full-time (12+ credits).
- Demonstrate good character.
- Minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.00.
- Demonstrate financial need.
- Hawai'i resident.

- Commitment to serve Hawai'i and its people demonstrated through extra curricular activities.
- Minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.00.

- Classified student enrolled at least half-time (6 credits).
- Minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.00.

J. M. Long Scholarship

- Classified student enrolled full-time (12+ credits).
- Pursuing a degree in health or business related field.
- Minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.00.
- Hawaii resident.

Martin Mammen Memorial Endowed Scholarship

- Classified student enrolled at least half-time (6 credits).
- Minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.00.
- Educational goal to obtain a baccalaureate degree.
- Financial need not necessarily as defined by federal guidelines.

Leighton Matsuyama Scholarship

- Classified student enrolled full-time (12+ credits).
- First priority given to students pursuing a degree in accounting.
- Second priority given to students pursuing a degree in business.
- Minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.00.
- Hawaii resident and US citizen.

Maui Auto Dealers Scholarship

- Priority given to student interested in Auto Body Repair and Painting and Auto Technology.
- Minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.00.
- Hawai'i resident.
- Financial need may be a consideration as defined by federal guidelines.

- Classified student enrolled at least half-time (6 credits) at MCC or UH Center on Maui.
- Priority will be given to students of Chinese ancestry.
- Preference will be given to graduating high school students.
- Minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.00.

Maui Contractors Association Scholarship

- Classified student enrolled full-time (12+ credits).

FILE A 2006/2007 FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). The FAFSA must be received and have a valid EFC by the US Department of Education by March 4, 2006. **You must list MCC's Federal School Code (001615) for all scholarships, even if you are a UH Center student.**

MCC SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM: Use the form provided and answer all questions.

PERSONAL STATEMENT: This is your opportunity to present yourself in the best possible light to the Scholarship Review Committee. **Please use 11 point font size or larger. Only one side of one page will be read.**

Submit a personal statement that answers the following questions:

- What are your reasons for attending college and for applying for this scholarship?
- Why did you choose your course of study?
- What are your educational/career goals?

Some scholarships were created for a target recipient and have a special priority category (gender, single parent, specific major/course of study). Please make sure that your personal statement addresses the criteria/priority listed in the scholarship pamphlet. Show the committee that you are a worthy recipient.

TWO LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION: Submit two (*only two*) letters of recommendation. *Please note that letters of recommendation from a relative are not acceptable.* The letters must have been written *within the last six months*, must include your full name, and be signed by the recommender. **Letters must be included in your application packet. Recommendation letters mailed separately will not be considered.** Letters must be no longer than *one* page in length.

TRANSCRIPTS: Send an official copy of your most recent transcript from the school that you last attended (high school or college).

- If you have completed at least one full-time semester's worth of work at MCC or any other school in the UH system, you do not need to request an official transcript. Indicate which UH school(s) you attended and we will request your transcript in-house and forward them to the scholarship review committee.
- If you have not been in school, high school or college, within the last five years, it is not necessary to submit a transcript. You may turn in your last college or high school transcript or you will be considered as a *reentry* student with a 2.00 cumulative GPA.
- If you believe that the MCC Admissions and Records Office is already holding official transcripts from schools you previously attended, please call 984-3267 to verify that your transcripts are on file. If confirmed, include a note in your application packet and we will request them in-house and forward them to the scholarship review committee.
