



Creation of an Ad Hoc Academic Integrity Committee (AIC)

Purpose: The academic integrity committee (AIC) serves to promote expectations for academic integrity consistent with college policy; support plagiarism prevention education for faculty and students; ensure fairness and consistency in processes and outcomes; investigate, review, record and settle/issue sanctions for reported cases of academic dishonesty within the college. Guidance and consultation will be made with the Vice Chancellor of Student Affairs.

Suggested Membership:

- 1 representative from Counseling
- 1 representative from Academic Support
- 1 representative from Outreach
- At least one tenured faculty
- At least one department chair
- Faculty from each department
- 1 representative from VC Student Affairs office (ex-officio), as needed per request of the committee.
