Western Undergraduate Exchange Program

The Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) is a program of the Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education (WICHE). Awards are available to entering freshmen and eligible transfer students. Priority consideration is provided if the eligibility requirements are met and you are admitted by February 1st. Students are encouraged to apply for admission to UHMC as early as possible.

Award Value

Through WUE, students in western states may enroll at UH Maui College at a discounted tuition of 150 percent of the institution’s regular resident tuition.

How much would you save with WUE?

Resident Tuition	\$3180
Non-Resident Tuition	\$9120
WUE Rate (Resident x 150%)	\$4770
WUE Savings	\$4350

Eligibility

You must be a resident of the following states:

Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Idaho, Montana, Nevada, New Mexico, North Dakota, South Dakota, Oregon, Utah, Wyoming, Washington State, or the Commonwealth of the Northern Marianas Islands.

****Your family’s domicile (home) must be maintained as your permanent address throughout the duration of your participation in the WUE program***

You must meet the following academic criteria:

- Freshmen applicants must have a 3.0 cumulative grade point average over four years in high school
- Transfer applicants must have a 2.8 cumulative grade point average with a minimum of 24 college transferable credits in order to qualify
 - GPA will be calculated using all colleges previously attended

You must pursue one of the following programs eligible for the WUE rate:

- Bachelor of Applied Science (BAS) Degree in Applied Business and Information Technology (ABIT)
- Bachelor of Applied Science (BAS) Degree in Engineering Technology (ENGT)
- Bachelor of Applied Science (BAS) Sustainable Science Management (SSM)

Restrictions

- Only undergraduate students and those who have not already earned a baccalaureate degree can qualify for WUE
 - WUE is awarded only once at the time of admission and will remain in effect for the duration of the student's academic career at UH Maui College
 - Non-WUE students who enroll as non-residents will not qualify for WUE status in later terms. Awards may not be available to all students who meet the criteria
 - WUE students must be enrolled in courses relevant to their degree requirements and must be enrolled full-time, in at least 12 credits each semester
 - WUE students must meet with an academic advisor before registering for courses
 - Hawaii residency cannot be established under the WUE program. Students changing their residency will be reclassified to non-resident. Students are only able to apply for Hawaii residency 12 months after cessation of WUE
