The curriculum is organized around a core of courses that provide skills and knowledge needed by early childhood educators. This Associate in Science in Early Childhood Education articulates into the UH West O'ahu Bachelor's in Social Science, Early Childhood Education concentration. **Additional courses are required for transfer to UH West O'ahu.
