



Mu'o A'e Native Hawaiian Student Success Program

Kuleana o ka haumāna

Haumāna (Student) responsibilities:

- 1. Attend classes on a regular basis
- 2. Maintain regular contact with the Mu`o A`e program staff
 - a. Return calls and/or emails within 3 business days
 - b. Notify program staff of address and/or telephone number changes
 - c. Attend all scheduled office visits at least twice a semester
 - d. Consult with my Mu`o Counselor before dropping or withdrawing from any courses, and/or changing to part-time status or withdrawing from school
- 3. If you place into both developmental math (Math 18) and developmental English (English 19), you must take one of these classes during the summer. (Tuition and books will be provided by our program).
- 4. *Enroll in English and math courses during the first year of your college career
- 5. Attend mandatory program orientations and activities
 - a. Attend one cultural development activity and two cultural workshops a semester
- 6. Submit periodic progress grade reports
- 7. Complete the FAFSA form annually
- 8. *Successfully complete at least one course that presents Hawaiian perspectives in Hawaiian culture, language, history, and philosophy (Any 100 or 200 level HAW or HWST course)
- 9. *Complete Interdisciplinary Studies/Student Success Course/s
- 10. Participate in one major fundraising event during the year by selling tickets

I understand that I must fulfill my kuleana (responsibilities) as a haumāna to remain in the Mu`o A`e program and receive full academic and support services. My signature demonstrates my commitment to participate in the Mu`o A`e program and fulfill my kuleana, consistent with `Ōlelo No`eau "`A`ohe `ulu e loa`a i ka pōkole o ka lou." This translates to "No breadfruit can be reached when the picking stick is too short." In other words, there is no success without preparation!
