We understand that you will soon attend the University of Hawai`i Maui College (UHMC), Molokai and wanted to welcome you on behalf of our Mu'o A'e Native Hawaiian Student Success Program funded by a Title III, U.S. D.O.E. Grant.

Our Mu'o A'e program provides academic services to **150 Native Hawaiian students** annually who meet the following eligibility criteria:

- 1) Admitted to UHMC in the spring or fall
- 2) Attending college for the first time
- 3) Attending school full-time
- 4) Placement in at least one developmental math or English course as indicated by Compass Placement scores; and
- 5) A desire to participate in the Mu'o A'e Program.

Participants will have access to a wide range of support services:

- Priority consideration for the Second Century Scholarship, contingent upon successful completion of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and financial need
- Mandatory summer orientation at Moloka'i Education Center, Skybridge Room 101 on August 9, 2012 from 1-3 p.m.
- First Year Experience program to help students transition onto the college academic ladder
- Peer tutoring and mentoring to enhance academic success
