# Maui Community College Counseling Department Assessment Reviews, Improvements and Modifications Implemented, Assessment of Improvements and Modifications

Assessments and modifications to services and functions of the Maui Community College Counseling Department for FY 2004 was based on weekly department meetings and annual retreat.

For FY 2005, the Department began work on reviewing the Council for the Advancement of Standards in Higher Education as a means of self-reflection, followed by the Department conducting a self-study and eventually working toward incorporating its findings into the next accreditation report to the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges.
