Exempt Status: The following students are exempt from registering from selective service but must provide proper documentation to prove exempt status.

- 1. Males born prior to 1960-Provide copy of original birth certificate.
- 2. A veteran-Provide DD214 or current fulltime active duty orders, military ID card.
- 3. Non-U.S. male who came into this country for the first time after his 26th birthday- Date of entry stamp in his passport, I-94 with date of entry stamp on it, or a letter from the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) indicating the date the man entered the United States. Document must also have birth date.
- 4. Non-U.S. male on a valid non-immigrant visa -For example, if the man entered the United States as an F-1 student visa and remained in that status until his 26th birthday, he would need to provide documentation indicating that he was admitted on an F-1 visa and attended school full-time as required.
- 5. Female student-Provide drivers license so that we may make a copy.
- 6. If you are not yet 18 Provide drivers license to verify your age and for us to make a copy. You must also answer 'Yes Register Me' to question 22 of the FAFSA.
